B		3826Q-X Island	1-1/3	BLOCKS: (3) 6-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (60) 2" x 6-1/2" rectangles. BINDING: (8) 2-1/4" x WOF strips.
C		3815Q-X Sky	2/3	BLOCKS: (3) 6-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (60) 2" x 6-1/2" rectangles.
D		3821Q-X Seafoam	1/2	BLOCKS: (2) 6-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (40) 2" x 6-1/2" rectangles.
E		3823Q-X Mint		
F		3817Q-X Caribbean		
G		3814Q-X Sky		
H		3819Q-X Fern

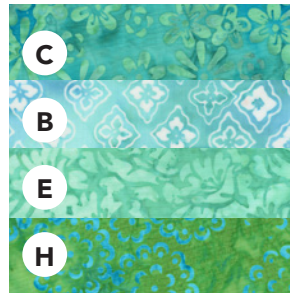




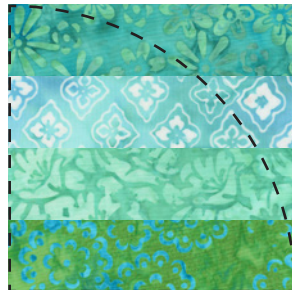
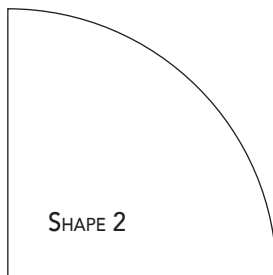
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PIECED BLOCKS

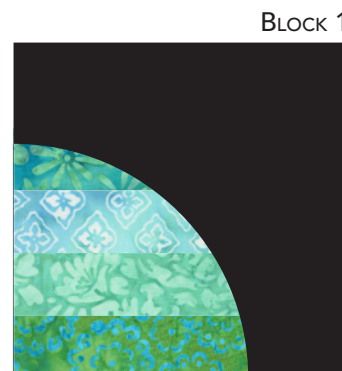
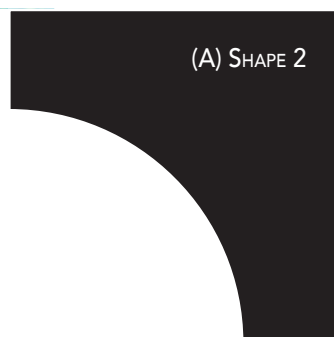
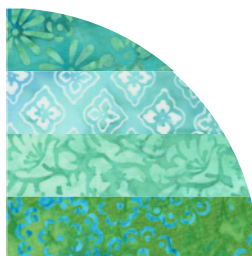
1. Arrange and sew together (4) 2" x 6-1/2" rectangles to make a pieced column in the following order: **C-B-E-H**. Square to 6-1/2". Make (20).



2. Place the template **Shape 2** in the lower left corner of (1) **C-B-E-H** Block as shown below. Trim along the curved edge of the template including seam allowance to create (1) **Pieced Trim Unit**.



3. Sew (1) **A Shape 1** to (1) **Pieced Trim Unit** as shown in the diagram below to complete (1) **Pieced Block**, measuring 8-1/2" square unfinished. Make (20).

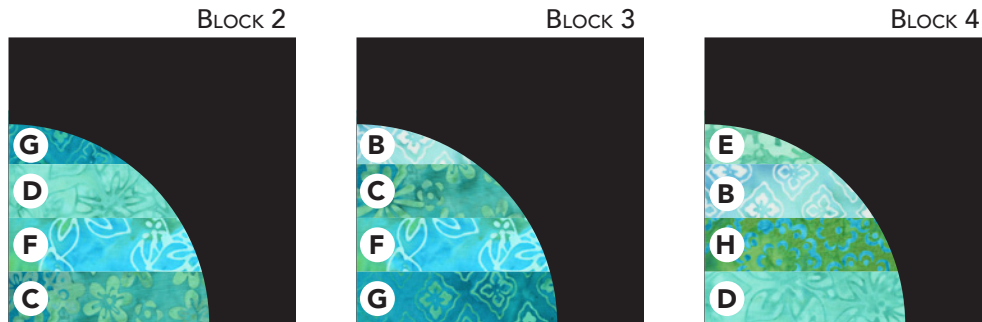


MAKE (20) OF **C/E/B/H** BLOCK.
MEASURES 8-1/2" SQUARE UNFINISHED.



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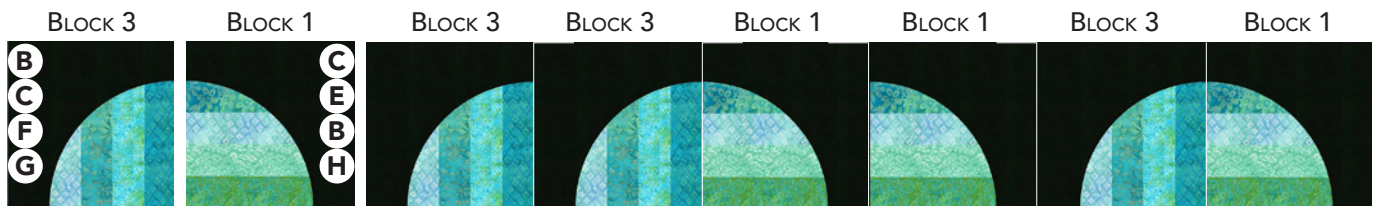
4. Repeat Steps 1-3 to make (20) Pieced Blocks each in the following fabric combinations:



QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

REFER TO THE QUILT DIAGRAM ON PAGE 4 FOR ROTATION AND PLACEMENT OF PIECED BLOCKS.

5. Pieced Row 1: Arrange and sew together (8) Pieced Blocks as shown.



6. Using the same process as in Step 5, complete the next (9) Pieced Rows. Then, sew all the rows together, one underneath the next, from Rows 1 to 10.

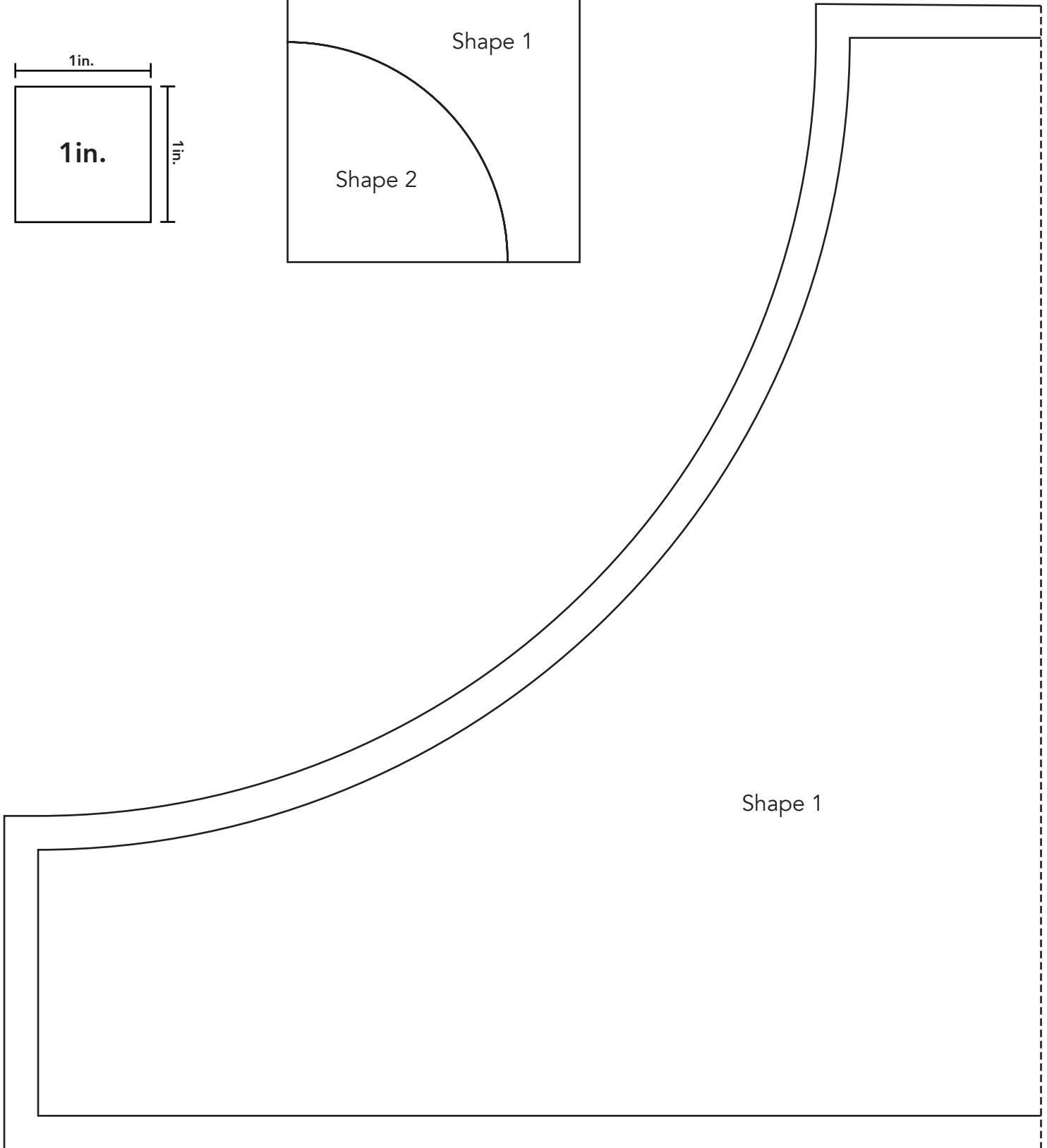
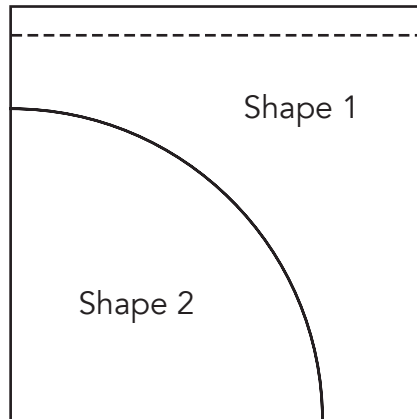
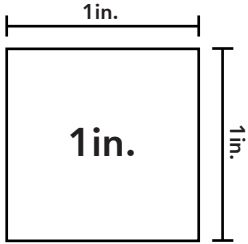

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich.
Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **B** 2-1/4" strips.
